SCOREKEEPERS GUIDELINES

Multiple Choice

- 1. Pick up your score sheets from the Head Scorekeeper.
- 2. Fill in Church, Club and Quizzers names.
- 3. Make sure that guizzers are ready to be guizzed when called up front.
- 4. You will also act as a judge. Make sure that quizzers do not make selections before they are told to do so or show their answers before asked to do so. In addition, watch for roving eyes. During the reading of the questions quizzers must look down at their paddles while deciding their answer. Violations result in non credit of points they may have earned on that question.
- 5. Listen to the Quiz Master for the correct answers, record ten (10) points for each correct answer. Incorrect answers designate with a "-". Use an "E" for eyes violation, and "V" for any other violation.
- 6. Total score sheets at the end of each teams segment of quizzing and turn them into the Head Scorekeeper.

Speed

- 1. Pick up your score sheets for Head Scorekeeper.
- 2. Have your clubbers ready to quiz when they are called up.
- 3. Be alert as the questions are read. The Quiz Master will recognize the clubber and will then indicate the correctness of the answer. Enter the result in the appropriate space. The twenty (20) points for a correct answer and minus ten (-10) for an incorrect answer. If the first quizzer responding is incorrect the next quizzer buzzing in will be given the opportunity to answer the question for ten (10) points if correct, minus five (-5) if incorrect.
- 3. If you have a question or a challenge on a particular question, it must be addressed **promptly**, NOT at the end of this quiz segment.
- 4. When a quizzer has answered three (3) questions correctly, he has "Quizzed Out". Immediately notify the Quiz Master, and give him the name and church of the successful quizzer. Award the quizzer twenty (20) bonus points on the appropriate space. When a quizzer has answered two (2) questions incorrectly, immediately notify the Quiz Master, you may replace the quizzer with your alternate of just take him out.

Please Note:

There are now 10 questions for the 'Multiple Choice' segment instead of 8 questions.

Remember the 'sliding scale' for speed quiz questions: 16 - 20 quizzers, 8 questions; 11 - 15 quizzers, 7 questions; 6 - 10 quizzers, 6 questions; and 1 - 5 quizzers, 5/6 questions (depending if a quizzer is ready to quiz out). The Champion Ribbon will only be awarded if there is a perfect score in Multiple Choice and that quizzer has 'quizzed out' with NO wrong answers.
